

Range Availability Notices -

The rifle and pistol ranges are normally available to members from 9:00 AM to sunset, Monday through Saturday. They are available from noon to sunset on Sundays and holidays. The list of holidays may be found under the [Club Rules](#) tab.

Special Notices -

The use of "**steel core**" ammunition is strictly prohibited on any rifle or pistol range at the club. The use of steel "shot" is permitted on shotgun fields.

The use of "**bump fire**" equipped or fully automatic weapons is strictly prohibited on any range at the club.

Patterning of shotguns is **NOT** allowed on the rifle or pistol ranges, nor is it allowed on the Skeet, Trap or 5-Stand fields. It **IS** allowed in the area that has been designated for that purpose at the left of Trap Field 2.

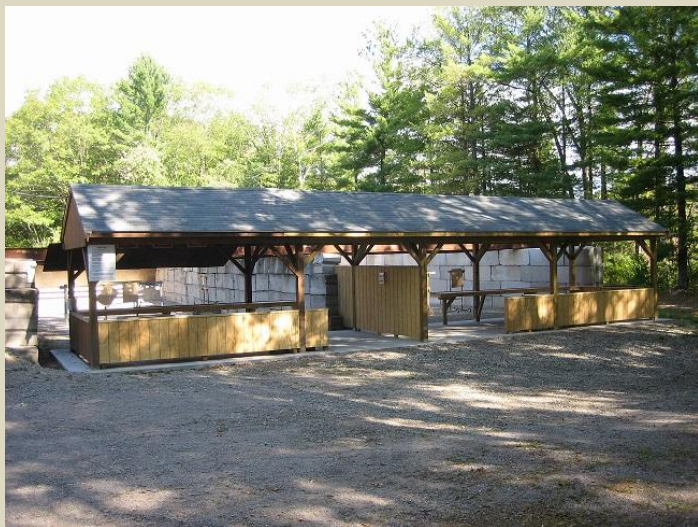

- 1. EYE AND EAR PROTECTION AT ALL TIMES.**
- 2. MUST SIGN IN AND OUT, GUEST INCLUDED. MEMBER IS RESPONSIBLE FOR GUEST.**
- 3. ONLY "CONTROLLED FIRE" IS PERMITTED. CONTROLLED MEANS ALL SHOTS ON TARGET. NO FULL AUTO, BUMP FIRE, OR SLIDE FIRE.**
- 4. PAPER TARGET POSITIONED SO THAT BULLETS IMPACT BACKSTOP. CLUB PROVIDED STEEL TARGETS ON PISTOL RANGE ONLY. NO PLINKING OR OTHER TARGETS.**
- 5. NO TANNERITE OR ANY OTHER EXPLODING OR INCENDIARY TARGETS OR AMMUNITION. NO STEEL CORE AMMUNITION.**
- 6. MEMBER AND GUESTS ARE REQUIRED TO PICK UP ALL TARGETS, TRASH, EMPTY CASES, ETC.**
- 7. CENTERFIRE RIFLES ARE NOT ALLOWED ON PISTOL RANGE.**
- 8. DO NOT RAISE ANY FIREARM ABOVE TARGET LINE. NO CROSSFIRING.**
- 9. ALL FIREARMS WILL BE UNLOADED AND OPEN WHEN ANYONE IS DOWN RANGE. NO HANDLING OF FIREARMS WHEN ANYONE IS DOWN RANGE.**
- 10. DRAWING FROM A HOLSTER IS NOT ALLOWED, UNLESS YOU ARE ACTIVE DUTY LAW ENFORCEMENT.**
